Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Redcliffe Way – Proposed Zebra Crossing

Notice is hereby given that **Arlen Hill** proposes to make a permanent Traffic Regulation Order under sections 1, 23 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce a new zebra crossing on Redcliffe Way.

The proposed changes

The proposal is to install a **zebra pedestrian crossing on Redcliffe Way**, in the vicinity of numbers 20–30 Redcliffe Way (exact location shown on the plan), together with associated road markings, signage and any necessary alterations to the highway layout.

The proposed zebra crossing is intended to:

- Improve pedestrian safety when crossing Redcliffe Way
- Support walking and access to local amenities
- Respond to concerns raised by residents about vehicle speeds and crossing difficulty
